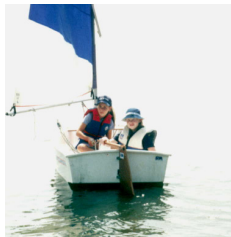

The Kent Community Foundation delivers The Local Network Fund in Kent and Medway, to local charities and community groups who are working with disadvantaged young people up to the age of 19 (or up to 25 where children have learning disabilities). We have nearly **£1million** to distribute this year in grants ranging from **£250 to £7,000**.

Eligible small projects that can apply must be run by Kent based groups, that include volunteers, and must have an annual turnover of less than £100,000. You can apply under one of the following themes:

1. **Economic Disadvantage:** schemes that help low income families.
2. **Isolation and Access:** isolated children in families and communities.
3. **Aspirations and Experiences:** opportunity to enjoy life through activities.
4. **Children's Voices:** letting children express themselves.



This fund is especially targeted at voluntary or community groups that are locally managed. Application packs can be obtained from the national information hotline **0845 1130161**.
